















#### **BAND PROGRAM STRUCTURE**

#### **Band Rehearsal**

- Bring water and face masks
- No food at practice
- Inside voices while in building
- Only parents are allowed at practice
- Stay in your practice area
- Schedule Breaks

#### **Band Rehearsal**

- First practice is October 12th & 13th
  - Middle School Monday & Tuesday
  - TNT Wednesday & Thursday
  - Fall Break October 14th-16th
- Physicals November 2nd

#### Band Rehearsal - Attire

- Appropriate practice attire is required at band rehearsal
  - Navy/orange/Black shorts
  - White/Gray/Black/Navy biker shorts ARE A MUST under regular shorts
  - White t-shirts or Band shirts
  - Tennis shoes (NO Converse/Sperry/Toms/Jordan)

# You will be dismissed from practice if you do not adhere to attire!

#### Band Rehearsal - Attendance

- Attendance is required
  - Attendance the day before a performance is MANDATORY
  - Tardies add to absences; 2 tardies is an absence
  - No Call No Show = Unexcused Absence
  - All tardies and absences needs to be communicated to coach by the parent






- Sign up to Team App. You will be sent an email to confirm your registration.
